Program Description

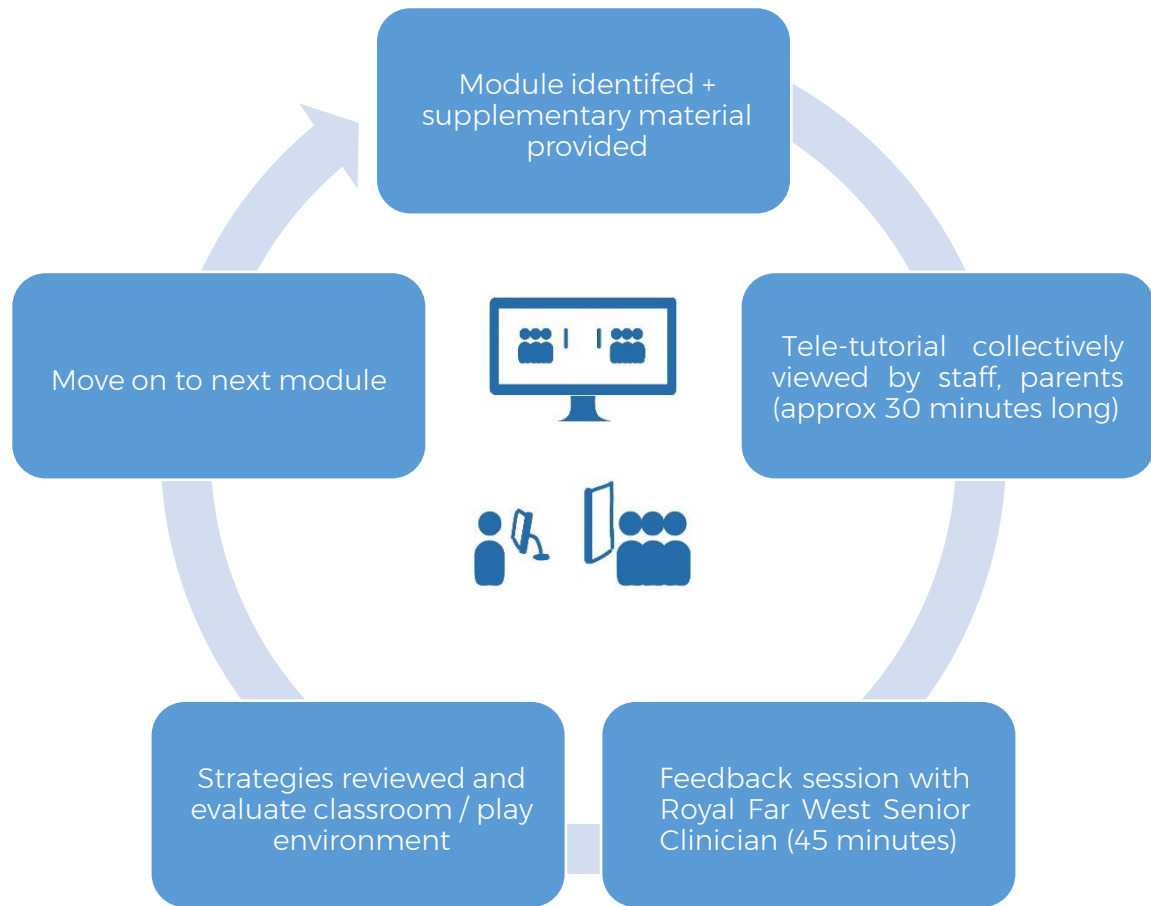
The Royal Far West (RFW) Capacity Building program is a technology-assisted service utilising a mixture of tele-tutorials, online resources, and video link with senior RFW clinicians. It is designed to empower teachers, volunteers, school support staff and/or parents to better support preschool or school-aged children experiencing difficulties with speech and language, sensory and motor development.
