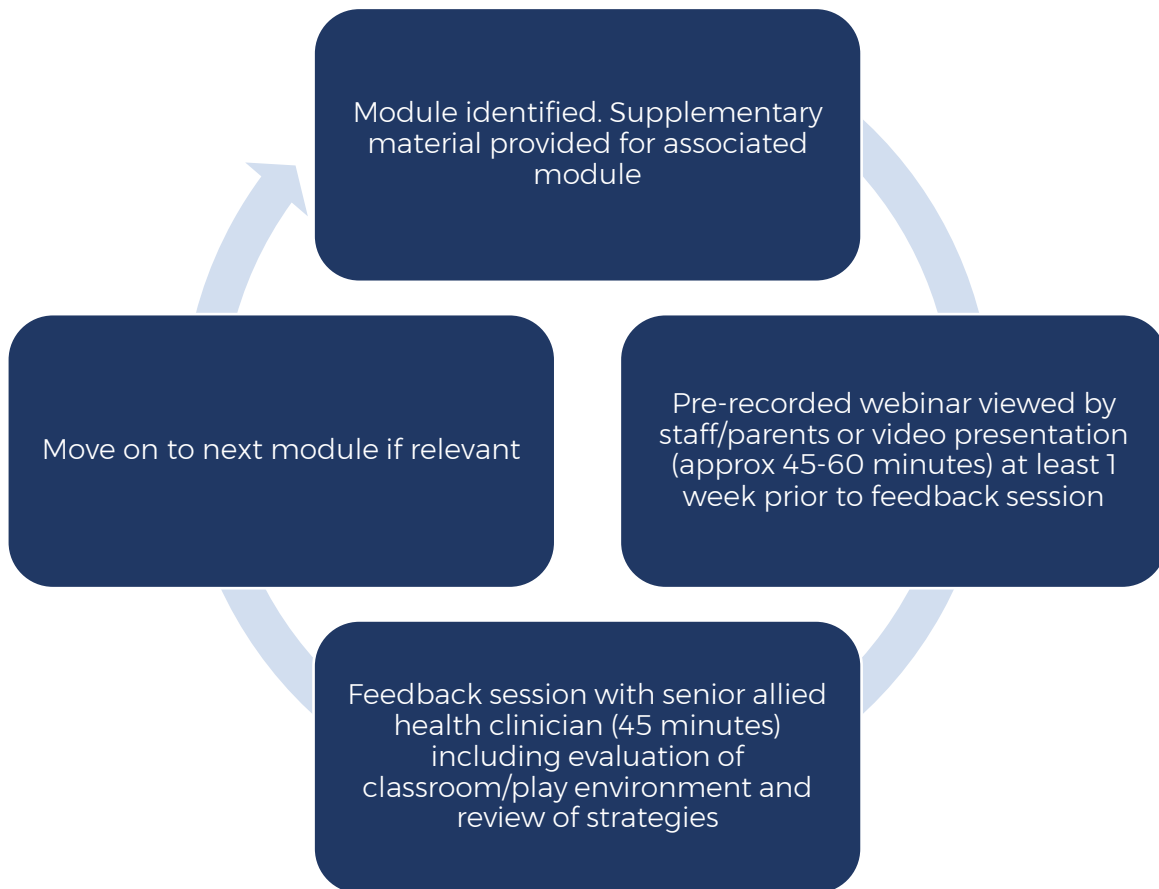
Capacity Building Program
